We collect or use the following information to **register supporters** including names and contact details, records of meetings and decisions, information relating to compliments or complaints, marketing preferences, recorded images, such as photos or videos, IP addresses, records of consent, where appropriate

Lawful bases

Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information for **service updates or marketing purposes** are consent and legitimate interest. We are a not for profit community group acting in the public interest to regenerate the Hamlet Court Road area. Public support for this work helps to underpin its validity including with things like our relationship with the local authority and funding bids. Collecting only limited contact information is of very low risk compared to the overall public benefit that can result.

Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information for **research or archiving purposes** are consent and legitimate interest. We are a community group acting in the public interest to regenerate the Hamlet Court Road area. Public support for this work helps to underpin its validity including with things like our relationship with the local authority and funding bids. Where we get personal information from

People directly

How long we keep information

Information will be kept for the duration of the Hamlet Court Calling project and deleted from file within 12 months of the end of the project or from when the information becomes outdated by supporter withdrawal or upon written request.

Who we share information with

Other organisations, publicly on our website, social media or other marketing and information media (where appropriate)

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal data. **Your right to rectification** - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal data you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete. **Your right to erasure** - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal data you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

Your right to withdraw consent – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the right to withdraw your consent.

You don't usually need to pay a fee to exercise your rights. If you make a request, we have one calendar month to respond to you.

How to complain
